This is one of those instances where OneStream can handle the situations in two ways: disable the user or delete the user. The recommended approach would be to turn the end-user's account of **Is Enabled** from **True** to **False**. This will disable the ability to even login into the application.

OneStream recommends this method over deleting a user. If an end-user is deleted, the record will be retained throughout the database. As an example, if an end-user John Smith (Username: JSmith) is terminated and the administrator deletes the user. This could create confusion in the future if the username is reapplied to a new employee with a similar name Jane Smith (Username: JSmith).
